FUND OBJECTIVE

The fund aims to achieve a target average return of 3% over cash before fees over a market cycle (typically 3 years) by investing in a diversified selection of hard currency-denominated (defined as USD, EUR, GBP, JPY, CHF) short duration sovereign and corporate bonds (debt securities) issued in emerging (less developed) market countries. Short duration securities have a shorter maturity (the date on which a bond is repaid to the investor) and a lower duration (sensitivity to changes in interest rates). There can be no guarantee that the fund will ultimately achieve its investment objective and capital is at risk. The fund systematically applies Environmental, Social and Governance ("ESG") criteria in the selection of securities.

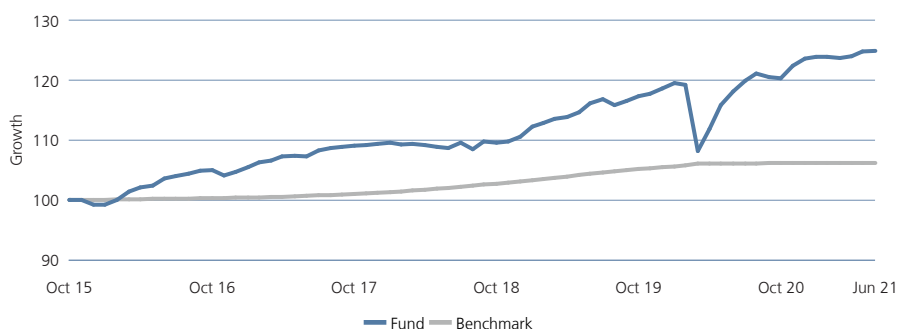

The annual yield figure quoted is the distribution yield, calculated by multiplying the dividend by pay periods, dividing by the net asset value (NAV) of the last distribution date and then multiplying by 100%. In respect of distributing share classes, the Directors of the Company may at their discretion pay dividends out of the capital of the Fund. Dividends paid out of capital amount to a return or withdrawal of part of an investor's original investment or from any capital gains attributable to that original investment. Such dividends may result in an immediate decrease in the net asset value (NAV) of the relevant shares. Dividends are not paid for all share classes and are not guaranteed. RISK CONSIDERATIONS

Market Risk: The risk of a change in the value of a position as a result of underlying market factors, including among other things, the overall performance of companies and the market perception of the global economy.

Liquidity Risk: The risk that the fund may be unable to sell an investment readily at its fair market value. In extreme market conditions this can affect the fund's ability to meet redemption requests upon demand.
