

Neuberger Berman US Small Cap Fund

Important Notes

1. The Fund invests primarily in equity securities issued by small-capitalisation companies which have their head office or exercise an overriding part of their economic activity in the US and that are listed or traded on recognised markets. The Fund therefore is subject to concentration risk and has greater exposure to political, legal and social risks of the US.
